Executive Summary our Mission Framework



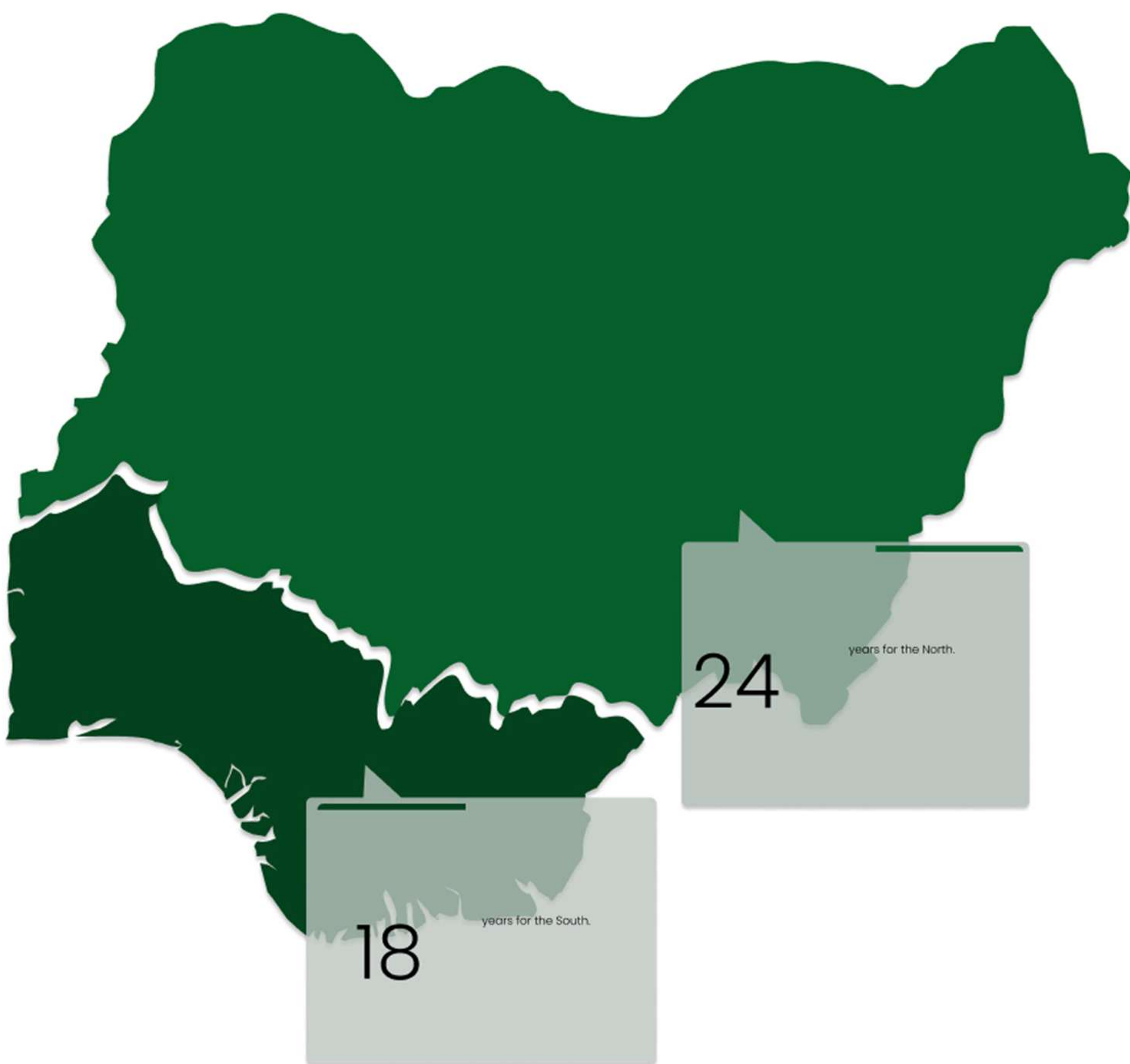

- ↑ The North has held the presidency for 24 years.
- ↓ The South has held the presidency for 18 years.

Organizational Structure

- Membership: PATRIOTS, comprising committee members, individual and organizational PATRIOTS.
- Committees: Established at all levels with statutory positions: National, State, LGA, Ward, and Cities.
- Stakeholders: Patrons and Matrons categorized by sponsorship level: Platinum, Diamond, Gold, Silver, and Bronze.
- Council of Elders: Advisory body providing guidance.
- Coordination Levels: Ambassadors (States), Supervisors (LGAs), Representatives (Wards +Units), Diaspora Affairs, Communities and Cities' point-men.

Implementation Plan

1. Implement proposed programs and activities. Carry out aggressive enlightenment and sensitisation.
2. Engage stakeholders, including patrons and matrons.
3. Mobilize and profile PATRIOTS towards elections. With a minimum target of 10 million members before 2027 general elections.
4. Commit to producing Governors, Senators, and House of Reps amongst our state Ambassadors across the party lines while recognising charter of equity.
5. Seek partnerships and collaborations with Federal Character Commission and other related establishments to domestic the ethos of the federal character principles and equality.
6. Our strategies also have statutory positions from NANS, TUC, NYCN, NLC, and CSOs in our national formation.
7. We are not partisan. Our membership is across party lines. We are for nobody but for Nigerian president of Southern extraction come 2027 general elections.
8. Commit to leading the same mandate/campaign for the North in 2031 general elections.
